CHAP. VI.

An Act against Atheism and Blasphemy.

213 Eit declared and enacted by the Lieutenant Governour, Council and Representatives, convened in General Court oz Allembly, and it is enacted by the Authozity of the fame, That if any Perfon shall prefume wilfully to blafpheme the holyName of God; Father, Son, or HolyGhoft; either by denying, curfing or reproaching the true God; his Creation or Government of the World: or by denying, curfing, or reproaching the holy Word of God; that is, the canonical Scriptures contained in the Books of theOld and New Teftament; namely GENESIS, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy, 70-Ibua, Judges, Ruth, Samuel, Samuel, Kings, Kings, Chronicles, Chronicles, Ezra, Nehemiah, Efther, Job, Pfalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, The Song of Solomon, Isaiah, Feremiah, Lamentations, Ezekiel, Daniel; Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkak, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, Malachi: MATTHEW, Mark, Luke, John, Acts, Romans, Corinthians, Corinthians, Galatians, Ephefians, Philippians, Coloffians, The falonians, The falonians, Timothy, Timothy, Titus, Philemon, Hebrews, James, Peter, Peter, John, John, John, Jude, Revelation : Every one fo offending fhall be punished by Imprisonment, not exceeding fix Months, and until they find Sureties for the good Behaviour; by fitting in the Pillory; by Whipping; boaring thorow the Tongue, with a red hot Iron; or fitting upon the Gallows with a Rope about their Neck; at the Difcretion of the Court of Affize, and General Goal Delivery, before which


• Whoever willfully blasphemes the holy name of God, his creation, government or final judging of the world, or by cursing or contentiously reproaching Jesus Christ or the Holy Spirit, or by cursing or contumeliously reproaching or exposing to contempt and ridicule, the holy word of God contained in the holy scriptures shall be punished by impriosonment in jail for not more than one year or by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars and may also be bound to good behavior.
